In the past few weeks I have heard (via concert, movies, etc.) a number of testimonies. They have been encouraging, uplifting, sad, happy and wonderful, all at once. I especially wanted to share about a recurring theme during these times when believers (Paul called them Saints) shared their hearts about how they came to faith in Christ. That recurring theme is music. Some had their hearts touched by a song that struck all the way to their soul. Others talked about how they grew up hearing and sharing the songs of the faith. Still others said that music had called them to come back and remember the God who had saved, loved and led them, even when they were not aware that God was there. Their voices and stories were powerful! Over the past several months, Andy, Tina, Renee Jones and several others have had the opportunity to share in a music experience called **Sing Global**. It was supposed to be a music-oriented conference in Nashville, but the high numbers of COVID cases caused it to be a virtual conference for us. We sat in the youth room and listened, learned and sang old and new songs of the faith. We heard testimony from new and old artists including Chris Tomlin, Bill Gaither and Joni Eareckson Tada. I 'googled' people like Michael W. Smith and Amy Grant. I listened as Zac Williams poured out his heart about how a song called him back to his childhood faith and from the brink of destruction.
